Federal order language requires these prices be based on weekly prices announced by the National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) on or before the 5th day of the month. In setting the price release dates for 2007, we failed to note that NASS was releasing their "Dairy Product Prices" report on Thursday, April 5th. We have determined that prices need to be recalculated using the five weeks of survey prices published in the April 5th NASS report. Consequently, prices and volumes for the survey week ending March 31st are included in the re-calculation.
